WE HAVE REOPENED FOR ROUTINE EYE CARE

The County of San Mateo Public Health Officer has adjusted the guidelines for essential services for all healthcare providers to once again allow for routine and preventative care. As a result, Optical Illusions of San Mateo has reopened our schedule for comprehensive eye exams and contact lens exams and fittings to take care of your ongoing eyecare and eyewear needs.

Your health and the safety of our staff and doctors remains our number one priority. As we are increasing our hours, we will continue to practice COVID-19 mindfulness and CDC safety procedures to provide eye care to you and your family in a safe environment. This requires everyone's participation.

We ask that you please wear a mask when you visit the office, come alone or use your car as an isolation waiting area, and reschedule if you are not feeling well. Upon entering the office, we will ask you screening questions on COVID-19 symptoms and ask that you immediately wash your hands or use the hand sanitizer we provide if you are not wearing gloves.

We have scheduled longer appointment times to allow for social distancing and disinfection between patient appointments. All equipment will be sterilized with CDC-approved cleaners. Each frame that is tried on will be cleaned and UV sterilized before being returned to the display. We will continually disinfect all common surfaces throughout the day.
